

18MN33646 - Fraud

On Sunday, December 16, 2018 at 10:13 am, a 19-year-old resident of Manalapan responded to police headquarters to report unauthorized charges on using her debit card. This victim reported that on November 23, 2018, an unknown individual conducted four transactions totaling \$18.79 for an unknown purchase.
