19MN02866- Warrant Arrest

On Sunday February 3, 2019 at approximately 1:03 a.m., patrols responded to the Manalapan Manor for a call. George Stryker, an unemployed 57 year old single Manalapan resident, was found to have an outstanding warrant out of the Ocean County Sheriffs Office with no bail. George was taken to the hospital where he was then turned over to the Ocean County Sheriffs Department. This incident and arrest were handled by Ptl. Jason Vigneault.
